I Will - I Will Love

Romans 12:9a

9 Love must be sincere.

Love Must Be sincere and visible.

1 John 3:18

18 Dear children, let us not love with words or speech but with actions and in truth.

Romans 5:8

8 But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

Romans 12:9

9 Love must be sincere. Hate what is evil; cling to what is good.

Sincere love hates evil.

Romans 12:21

21 Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.

Sincere love is humble.

Romans 12:10b

10 Honor one another above yourselves.

Romans 12:16b

Do not be proud, but be willing to associate with people of low position. Do not be conceited.

Sincere love is generous.

Romans 12:13

13 Share with the Lord's people who are in need. Practice hospitality.

Romans 12:16a

16 Live in harmony with one another.

Romans 12:18

18 If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone.

Sincere love is peacemaking.

Sincere love is loving those who are hard to love.

Romans 12:14

14 Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse.

Matthew 5:43-47

43 "You have heard that it was said, 'Love your neighbor¹ and hate your enemy.' 44 But I tell you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, 45 that you may be children of your Father in heaven. He causes his sun to rise on the evil and the good, and sends rain on the righteous and the unrighteous. 46 If you love those who love you, what reward will you get? Are not even the tax collectors doing that? 47 And if you greet

only your own people, what are you doing more than others? Do not even pagans do that? 48 Be perfect, therefore, as your heavenly Father is perfect.

We are never done loving.

Romans 13:8-10

8 Let no debt remain outstanding, except the continuing debt to love one another, for whoever loves others has fulfilled the law. 9 The commandments, "You shall not commit adultery," "You shall not murder," "You shall not steal," "You shall not covet,"[a] and whatever other command there may be, are summed up in this one command: "Love your neighbor as yourself."[b] 10 Love does no harm to a neighbor. Therefore love is the fulfillment of the law.

Prayer Direction

Pray for the heart of Jesus so that you can love people with His love. Ask God to give you eyes to see people in your life you need to love more intentionally. Pray for God to show you specifically how you are to love them this week.
