Bible Story: More Than This (On the Road to Emmaus) • *Luke 24:13-35*

Bottom Line: There's always more to discover about God's plan.

Memory Verse: *Don't do anything only to get ahead. Don't do it because you are proud. Instead, be humble. Value others more than yourselves.* Philippians 2:3 (NIRV)

Life App: Humility—Putting others first by giving up what you think you deserve

Activity #1- Bible Story

Parents, read through this week's Bible story with your child or check out our video teaching on [Shoreline's website](#). This week we are learning about Jesus and the men on the road to Emmaus.

Activity #2- Discussion Questions

1. What do you think was the most important thing the men on the road to Emmaus discovered?
2. What did you discover from this story?
3. Why is it so hard for us to admit when we don't know something?
4. Have you ever had someone tell you or teach you something you already knew? How do you show humility in that kind of situation?
5. What have you discovered about God that has surprised you?

Parents: Make It Personal. Share something you recently discovered about God as you listened to a sermon or podcast, read your Bible, discussed your faith with someone, or another way God opened your eyes to something new.



Activity #3- Others First (Elementary Activity)

What you need: Clear plastic tub of water, items that will sink or float

What you do:

- Set out a tub of water and "sink or float" items. Have your kids guess which items will sink and which ones will float and have them sort them into the two categories.
- Let them drop each item into the water to see what happens.
- After the experiment read 1 Peter 5:5 and then talk about the experiment.

Discuss:

- How confident were you that you knew which items would sink and which ones would float?
- How did it feel when you were wrong?
- In light of the verse we just read, what are some ways we can, "Put [humility] on as if it were your clothes" (NIRV) when it comes to learning something new or possibly being wrong about something?
- Let's look at the last sentence of this verse: "But he gives grace to those who are humble," (NIRV) What does that mean to you?
- Tell kids that since God wants us to approach everything with an attitude of humility, that means He'll help us do just that!

Preschool Activity- Who and Where Can We Tell People About Jesus

What you need: A piece of paper and something to write with

What you do:

- Draw a vertical line down the center of the paper. On the left side write "WHO" and on the right side write "WHERE".
- Ask your child to name people they can tell about Jesus and write their responses down. Then move to the "WHERE" side and ask them to name places they go where they can tell others about Jesus.
- Have your child draw pictures next to the names of the people and places you wrote down to help them remember who they can tell that **Jesus is alive!**
