Week Two Discussion Questions

1. Jesus knew exactly what He was doing; He was preparing to go to the Cross. How is the knowledge that Jesus had (and still has) grasp and control of all situations?
2. What stands out to you in the scene of Jesus washing all His disciples' feet and His explanation to His disciples? In what way does that challenge you in following the example He set?
3. Peter was highlighted in John 13 several times. How does Peter's behavior look familiar to things you see in people today as they try to grasp who Jesus is and follow Him? What do you see in yourself that reminds you of Peter?
4. What attributes, character, or emotions do you see in Jesus in John 13? Which of these is the hardest area for you to be Christ-like? Which do you wish to emulate this week?
5. Jesus gave us a command to "love one another" as He had loved us. Give examples of what that kind of love might look like today? What is one opportunity you have before you right now that is an opportunity to "love one another" more like this?
6. What stood out to you that we have not yet discussed?
