What does celebration look like?

He is my [shelter](#) and [rest](#) (v.1)

Psalm 91:1

Whoever dwells in the shelter of the Most High will rest in the shadow of the Almighty.

What can I do to seek rest and shelter in the God who made me?

He is my [refuge](#) and [fortress](#) (Safety) (v.2 & 2 Thess. 3:3)

Psalm 91:2

I will say of the Lord, "He is my refuge and my fortress, my God, in whom I trust."

2 Thessalonians 3:3

But the Lord is faithful, and he will strengthen you and protect you from the evil one.

How can I run to God when the enemy attacks?

He is my [salvation](#) (v.3-4)

Psalm 91:3-4

Surely he will save you from the fowler's snare and from the deadly pestilence. He will cover you with his feathers, and under his wings you will find refuge; his faithfulness will be your shield and rampart.

Why is it so important that we remember the saving work of Jesus over and over again?

He is my [confidence](#) (v.5-8 & 2 Thess. 3:4)

Psalm 91:5-8

You will not fear the terror of night, nor the arrow that flies by day, nor the pestilence that stalks in the darkness, nor the plague that destroys at midday. A thousand may fall at your side, ten thousand at your right hand, but it will not come near you. You will only observe with your eyes and see the punishment of the wicked.

2 Thessalonians 3:4

We have confidence in the Lord that you are doing and will continue to do the things we command.

What has God done in the past that makes you confident in His faithfulness for the future?

He is my **protector** (v.9-13 & 2 Thess. 3:2)

Psalm 91:9-13

If you say, "The Lord is my refuge," and you make the Most High your dwelling, no harm will overtake you, no disaster will come near your tent. For he will command his angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways; they will lift you up in their hands, so that you will not strike your foot against a stone. You will tread on the lion and the cobra; you will trample the great lion and the serpent.

2 Thessalonians 3:2

And pray that we may be delivered from wicked and evil people, for not everyone has faith.

Where do you need God's protection today?

He is my greatest **love** (v.14-16 & 2 Thess. 3:5)

Psalm 91:14-16

"Because he loves me," says the Lord, "I will rescue him; I will protect him, for he acknowledges my name. He will call on me, and I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble, I will deliver him and honor him. With long life I will satisfy him and show him my salvation."

2 Thessalonians 3:5
