



## Passionate Prayer

### Growth in Communicating with God One-on-One and in Community with Others

Passionate prayer includes speaking to God often as well as listening for God's voice, promptings, and whispers at all times. It also means that we pray often with other believers and seek God's face in community. In addition, a life of passionate prayer will lead us to pray for and with those who are not yet followers of Jesus. Prayer is a wonderful array of praise, thanks, supplication (asking for God's help and intervention), confession, and so much more. A growing disciple will go deeper and deeper into prayer and this intimacy with God will lead us to love, serve, and share the love of Jesus with lost people.

#### Indicators of Growth:

1. **Confidence** - helps us rely on the Lord for all things in our life. It will enable us to push forward in the direction that we are called because God is governing and leading. It makes us realize we are not responsible for the results of prayer--our part is to surrender and live in obedience. (Philippians 4:13)
2. **Devotion** - aligning personal desires, plans, worship, and hope with God. In prayer, we declare, "Your will be done!" (Colossians 3:2; Matthew 6:10; Luke 22:42)
3. **Submission** - with awe and reverence, surrendering and yielding our will and plans over to God's guidance as He leads us through Scripture and prayer. (Ephesians 5:21)
4. **Honor** - seeking to honor God with actions and prayer. (Psalms 22:23)
5. **Frequency** - learning to pray at all times, with eyes closed and eyes open.  
(1 Thessalonians 5:17; John 17:1)
6. **Community**- making prayer a normative part of being with other believers and learning to pray for and with non-believers. (Acts 1:14 & 4:24)

#### Ideas for Action to Grow in Passionate Prayer:

1. Set a time and place for prayer each day and be consistent.
2. Keep a prayer journal that includes answered prayers and prayers for people who do not yet know Jesus.
3. Use a prayer list for groups such as family, pastors, friends, people who need to meet Jesus, local leaders, state leaders, national leaders, and world leaders, and others you care about.
4. Seek to break out in spontaneous prayer and worship in the flow of an ordinary day

- when you have moments alone with God.
5. Commit to attending church weekly, even when you are out of town, and pray for churches you visit and for churches you drive by in the flow of the day.
  6. Pray with others when they share a need or joy.
  7. Take a 15 to 30-minute retreat where you listen to God's voice. Turn off your devices, but take a piece of paper and something to write down ways you sense the Lord is guiding you.
  8. Memorize and lift up prayers that others have prayed (from the Bible and from Christians who have gone before you).
  9. Pray the Psalms.
  10. Prayer-walk your neighborhood, workplace, or community. As you walk, pray out loud or silently. It could be fun to do this with one or two other Christians.
  11. Pray as you drive around your town. If you pass a civic building, pray for those in governmental leadership. As you pass a school, pray for the students, teachers, parents, administrators, and school board members. When you drive by a church, pray for the pastors, board members, congregational members, and for revival! Pay attention to the Holy Spirit as you drive...with your eyes wide open!
